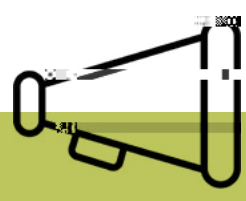

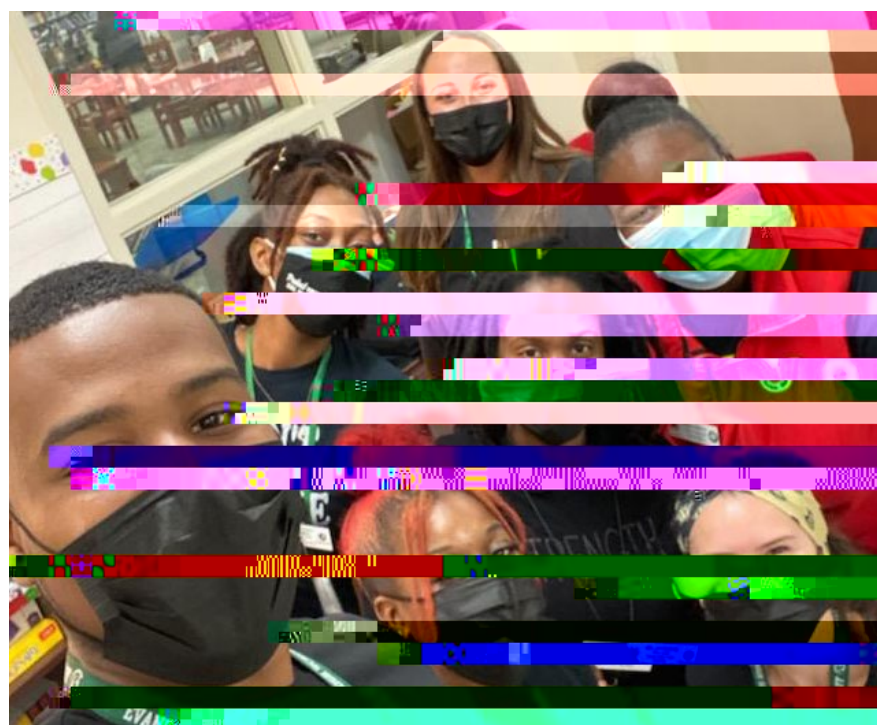
JOYS

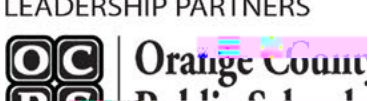
